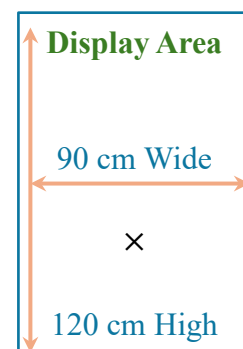




## INFORMATION FOR POSTER PRESENTERS

### Poster Panel Size

Please refer to the poster panels to be used during the congress. *The display area for each poster on the panel of the poster board is 90cm wide by 120cm high* , It is recommended that leaving a margin of at least 7 cm around the poster.



### Poster Panel Allocation

Panels will be allocated for each poster(separate from the abstract number you have been assigned) and staff will be on hand at the congress to provide your poster panel number. Please ensure that you stand by your poster(s) during your session for discussion and questions. You will be notified of your allocated session shortly along with set up and tear down times.

### Fixing

Secretariat will have some available fixing materials for delegate use at the congress.

## GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRODUCTION

Presentations should be kept simple and clear and a mixture of text and graphics is recommended.

### Poster Layout

Recommending an **introduction** be placed at the upper left and a **conclusion** at the lower right.

### Illustrations

Figures should be designed to be viewed from a distance and should use clear, visible graphics and large type. Each figure or table should have a heading. Additional essential information should be provided below in a legend. **Photographs should have good contrast, sharp focus.**

### Text

Minimise narrative. Use large type in short, separated paragraphs. Numbered or bulleted lists are effective ways to convey a series of points.

### Titles and Fonts

Titles and captions should be short and easy to read. Remember to caption your poster with the abstract title, authors names, affiliations and e-mail. **Headings should be a minimum of 55 point size, whereas,30-35 point size is suitable for text.**
